Under this perspective , we would like to acquaint you with the new guidelines strategically planned keeping in mind the various requirements for the forthcoming session 2021-22.

The specific guidelines are:-

- Parents are requested to collect the I-card forms from the respective class teachers, fill in the details correctly and submit it to the respective class teachers by 5th of April,2021.
- The new academic session 2021-22 will start from **5th April 2021 i.e. Monday for classes Joyful Junior to Grade XII.**

The scheduled summer offline/ online class timings w.e.f 05.04.2021 are as follows:

School timings: Joyful Juniors to grade XII 7:30 a.m. to 11.30 a.m.

BOOKS AND STATIONARY:

- Books & Stationary can be procured from all leading book stores, the book list will also be uploaded in Google classroom and School website for convenience of the students.

UNIFORM:

- The new School Uniform(design/pattern/colour) is displayed on the School Notice Board and also at Dress land , opposite Vishal Mega Mart, near sweet India, Main Road , Ranchi. Parents are free to procure it from any uniform shop of Ranchi .
- The revised school uniform is mentioned as under:

Boys (regular uniform) –	1. Half shirt cream colour. 2. Half pant with colour scheme Mixture Coffee Checks
Boys (P.T uniform)	same as last year.
Boy's shoes and socks	1. Liberty shoes of (dark brown colour) as usual with Velcro and socks - Same as last year
Girls (regular uniform)	1. Same as last year 2. Skirt with colour scheme of Mixture Coffee Checks.
Girls (P.T. uniform)	same as last year.
Girls shoes and socks	Liberty shoes of brown (dark tan colour) as usual with Velcro and socks -- Same as last year
The bow has been replaced with tie for both junior boys and girls.	

<u>Grades III to XII :</u>	
Boys (regular uniform):	same as last year. Full Pant with colour scheme Mixture Coffee Checks
Boys (P.T. uniform)	same as last year
Boy's shoes and socks	Liberty shoes of (dark brown colour) as usual with lace and socks – same as last year
Girls (regular uniform)	1. Same as last year. 2. Divider Skirt with colour scheme of Mixture Coffee Checks- knee length.
Girls (P.T. uniform)	same as last year.
Girls shoes and socks:	Liberty shoes of brown (dark brown colour) as usual with lace and socks – same as last year
The bow has now been replaced with tie for both senior boys and girls.	

Note: There is no change as such in the winter uniform and will be continued as per the same colour scheme and pattern. If any changes are brought about, it will be intimated officially to the students as well as the parents.

GENERAL:

- Parents whose children would use school transport may please contact Mr Bijay Raj Verma (Transport In charge)
- **Attendance is mandatory on the first day of the new session ,strict disciplinary action will be imposed on the students not attending the classes regularly.**
- The walkers will report to the school by **7. 20 AM.**
- There will be 45 minutes online classes conducted in the evening as well, timely information regarding the same will be given to the students.
- The first page of the school diary must be filled properly with authentic details; change of contact no. or address must be updated instantly.
- Please adhere to school Policy of “**NO TUTION**”. The school does not advocate or encourage any private tuition as we consider it to be the greatest hindrance in the progressive development of the child.
